**Subject** Declaration of tacit consent for an EWSR waste shipment to  
transit through the territory of the Netherlands

The Human Environment and Transport Inspectorate (ILT) hereby declares that it does not issue written decisions on individual applications for the transit of waste shipments through the territory of the Netherlands. This means that the ILT grants tacit consent for transit. The legal basis for this is Article 9(1) of the European Waste Shipment Regulation (EWSR).

**When the tacit consent takes effect**

The tacit consent takes effect 30 days after the competent authorities of the country of destination have notified the notifier that the EWSR notification is complete.

**Entry into force and validity of pre-approved facilities**

If the consignee holds pre-consented recovery facility status, the tacit consent takes effect within 7 working days of the date on which the competent authorities of destination have confirmed to the notifier that the EWSR notification is complete. In this case, the tacit consent remains valid for a maximum of 3 years, in accordance with Article 14(12) of the EWSR.

**No confirmation of tacit consent**

The ILT does not send a written or digital confirmation of tacit consent for each individual EWSR notification.
